


Various rural development programmes launched by Govt. of India




Rural development is the process of improving the quality of life and economic well-being of people living in rural areas, often relatively isolated and sparsely populated areas. Rural development has traditionally centered on the exploitation of land-intensive natural resources such as agriculture and forestry.

The term 'Development' means quantitative as well as qualitative change. Since it means change, which has meaning only when seen against Empowering Communities... something at a particular time, it carries a meaning which is not only relative but also subjective. Only a given type of quantitative cum-qualitative change is considered to be development in a positive sense. If the change is not of appreciable quality, and quantity, it is either maldevelopment or negative development In the same sequence

The concept of rural development was borne in the context of agriculture and for a long time it encompassed agricultural development Since 1970s, the concept has become more definite in its interpretation and it is being regarded as a design to improve the economic and social life especially, by extending benefits of development to the poorest



The modern concept of Extension education is the means for achieving community development, includes several facets and subject- matter fields, of which agriculture is more important than the others. Hence "Agricultural extension" may be defined as special branch of Extension Education which deals with the economic and social aspects of people engaged in or associated with agriculture.
