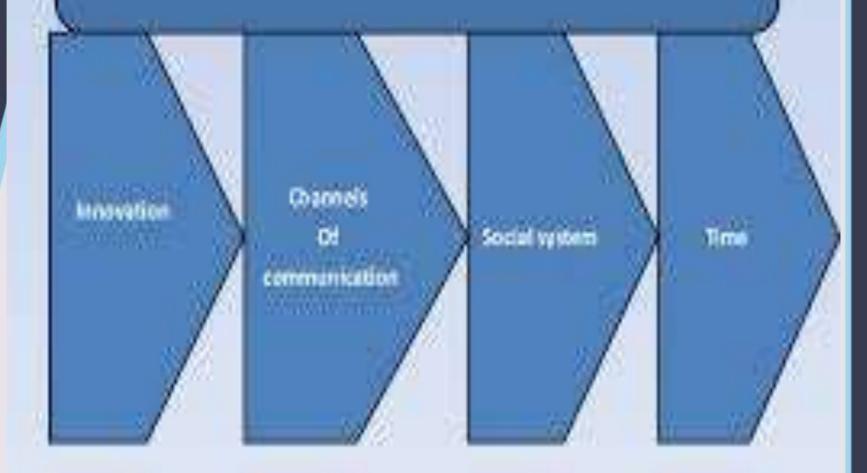
#### **Diffusion and Adoption of Innovation**

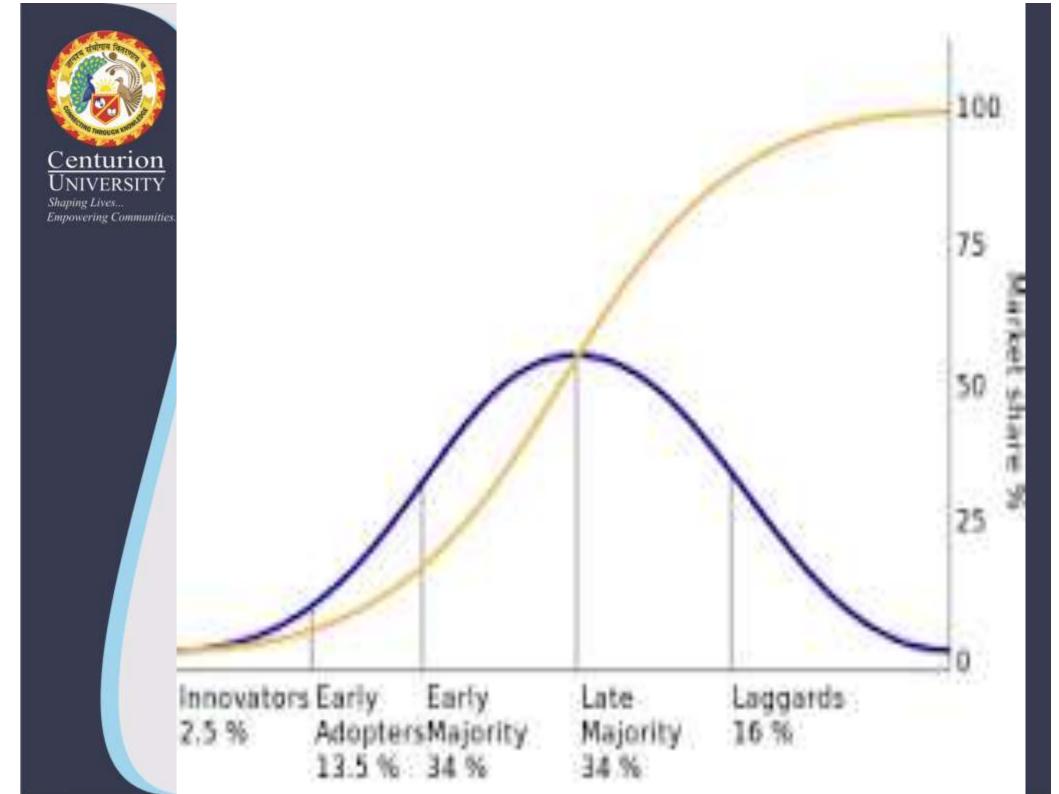
 Diffusion is a macro process concerned with the spread of a new product from its source to the consuming public.

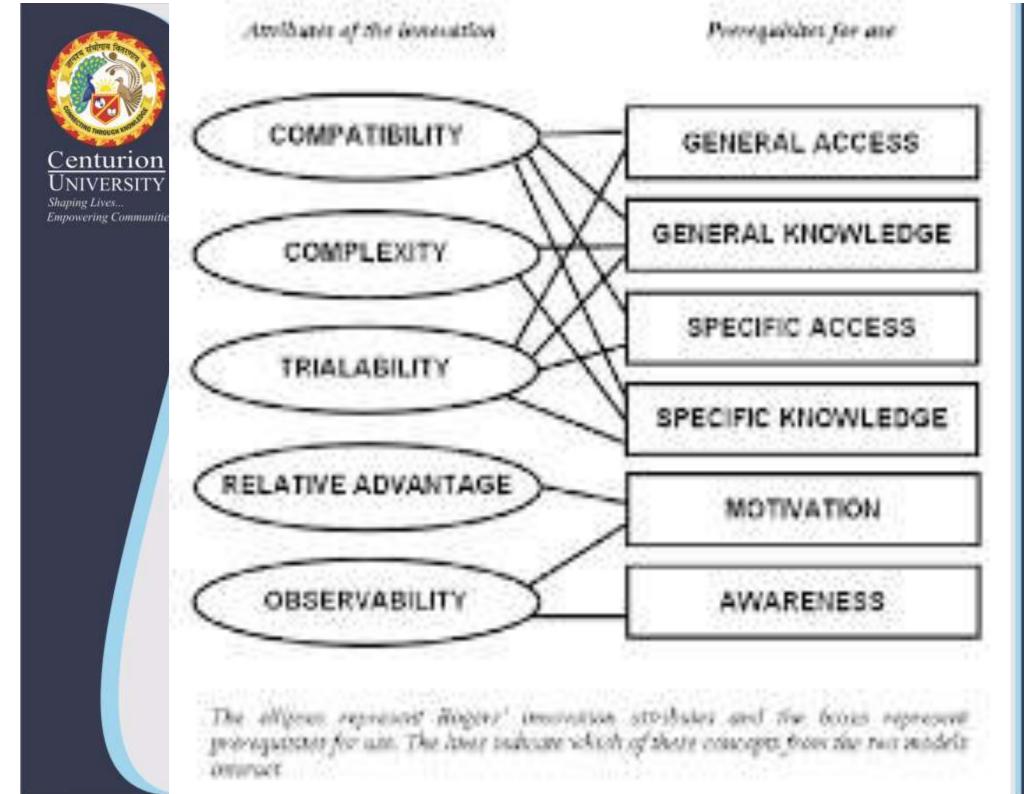


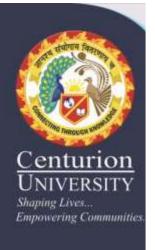

•The degree to which an innovation is perceived as being better than the idea or gractice is replaces. Relative advantage is associated with economic profitability. However, aconomics is not the only consideration is determining relative advantage. Ecomple: Astophion of the new core society may yield higher economic profitibility due to inglier yields from less peet pressure and lower projector cest.

 The degree to which an inequation is perceived as consistent with the existing values, past experiences, and eards of potential adopters.
 Each inequation must be compatible with an individual client's values, ideas, and needs.

 The degree to which an introvation is perceived as difficult to understand and use. The more complex the innovation, the slower the rate of adoption.

 The degree to which as innovation map be experimented with on a landed basis. Example: Core Producers may be willing to try the new wavery an Arched acreage to assess its merit.

•The degree to which the results of an innovation are elable to others. The easier it is for others to see the results of an innovation, the more likely they will adopt it. Complex if Producer A is successful in increasing pield and obtaining higher profits with a new corn variety. Pradaters 8, C and D will be more likely to plant the new seriety as well.
