Structure of DNA:

In 1953 James Watson and Francis crick, based on the X-ray diffraction data produced by Maurice Wilkins and Rosalind Franklin, proposed a very simple but famous and universally accepted double helix model for the structure of DNA. The silent features of double helix structure of DNA are listed below.

Structure of RNA:

RNA is a polynucleotide and RNA nucleotides have ribose sugar, which participate in the formation of sugar phosphate backbone of RNA. Thymine is absent and is replaced by uracil. Usually RNA is a single stranded structure. Single stranded RNA is the genetic material in most viruses E.g. - TMV. Double stranded RNA is also found to be the genetic material in some organisms. E.g. - Plant wound and tumor viruses.
