












Three tier Structure of PRI Man The Assess Paraheeuti Rei No. 2004





Introduction

- A Gram Panchayat is the cornerstone of a local self government organisation in India
- GP is the lowest unit of the Panchayati Raj Institute at village level, governed by the 73rd Amendment which is concern with rural local government
- The GP is divided into wards and each ward is represented by a ward member, also refers to as a <u>Panch</u>
- The Panchayat is chaired by the president of the village, known as a <u>Sarpanch</u>
