Introduction Sum of Products(SOP)

SUMS OF PRODUCTS FORM(SOP)

A Product term is any group of literals appearing either in complemented or uncomplemented form, that are AND ed together. Two or more product terms are OR ed together, to form a sum of products expression.

Example: F=AB+ACB+AC+BD where AB,ACB,AC and BD are product terms.

PRODUCT OF SUMS FORM (POS)

A sum term is any group of literals appearing either in complemented or uncomplemented from that are OR ed together. Two or more sum terms are AND ed together to form a product of sums expression.

Example: (A+B)(A+B+C)(C+B)(B)

where A+B; A+B+C; C+B; and B are sum terms

CANONICAL SUM OF PRODUCTS

A sum of products expression is referred to as canonical sum of products or standard sum of products expression if every product term involves every literal or its complement.

Example: F=ABC+ABC+ACB+ABC

Where ABC,ABC,ACB and ABC are the product terms involves all the literals A, B and C.

CANONICAL PRODUCT OFSUMS

A product of sums expression is referred to as canonical product of sums or standard product of sums expression if every sum term involves every literal.

Example :
$$F = (A+B+C+D)(A+B+C+D) (A+B+C+D)$$

(A+B+C+D)

Where (A+B+C+D);(A+B+C+D); (A+B+C+D); (A+B+C+D) are sum terms involves all the literals A, B, C and D.

Minterm:

A product term which contains each of 'n' variables as factors in either complemented or in complemented form is called a Minterm.

Maxterm:

A sum term which contains each of 'n' variables as factors in either complemented or uncomplemented form is called a Maxterm.

Conversion from SOP to standard or canonical SOP form.

To convert SOP to cononical SOP form the following steps are required.

(1) Examine each term; if it is a minterm, retain it and continue to the next term.

(2) In each product which is not a minterm, check the variables that do not occur; for each xi that does not occur, multiply the product by (x

For example for a three variable function (x, y, z) if a term contains only x, y, which is not a minterm multiply x y with ().z z+

(3) Multiply out all products and eliminate redundant terms.
