Strong ammonium acetate solution

**Aim:** To prepare and dispense 30ml of strong ammonium acetate solution.

Requirements: Glacial acetic acid, ammonium bicarbonate, ammonium solution

strong, purified water, beaker, glass rod, measuring cylinder.

**Principle:** Strong ammonium acetate solution was prepared by chemical reaction method. It is used as a mild expectorant, diaphoretic and diuretic. In this solution strong ammonia is used to neutralize the excess glacial acetic acid and obtain a condition of neutrality. To avoid the incompatibility of ammonium acetate and lead. It forms lead acetate which may turn to a turbid solution. So the solution is

filled in a lead free glass bottle.

Procedure:

1. Mix glacial acetic acid, ammonium bicarbonate, 10ml of purified water.

2. Strong ammonia is added to the above solution (Ammonia is added to obtain a

condition of complete neutralization, pH approximately between 7-8).

3. Dilute the preparation with purified water to produce the desired volume.

4. Fill the solution in a lead free glass bottle and label it.

Label:

**Use:** Mild expectorant, diaphoretic and diuretic.

**Storage:** Stored in a lead free glass bottle, in a cool place.

Dose: 1-5ml
