Solve the LPP by Penalty (Big-M) method

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Max Z} &= \text{-2X1 - X2} \\ \text{Subject to} & 3\text{X1} + \text{X2} &= 3 \\ & 4\text{X1} + 3\text{X2} &\geq 6 \\ & \text{X1} + 2\text{X2} &\leq 4 \\ & \text{X1} &\geq 0, \, \text{X2} &\geq 0 \end{aligned}$$

Solve the LPP by Big-M/Penalty method

Maximize
$$R = 5X - 2Y - Z$$

$$2X + 2Y - Z \ge 2$$
 Subject to $3X - 4Y \ge 3$
$$Y + 3Z \ge 5$$
 $X, Y, Z \ge 0$

Use penalty (or Big 'M') method to

Minimize $z = 4x_1 + 3x_2$ subject to the constraints: $2x_1 + x_2 \ge 10$, $-3x_1$, $+2x_2 \le 6$ $x_1 + x_2 \ge 6$, $x_1 \ge 0$ and $x_2 \ge 0$.
