

# Session 1: Scope and current scenario of therapeutics in aquaculture

- The Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations (FAO) attributes aquatic organisms that are harvested by an individual or corporate body that has owned them throughout their rearing period to aquaculture, while aquatic organisms that are exploitable by the public as a common property resource, with or without appropriate licenses, are harvested by fisheries .
- The contribution of wild-catch fisheries as a protein source for human consumption plateaued in the mid 1980s, and since then, most natural stocks in marine waters have been harvested at or near maximum rates.
- According to the FAO, aquaculture remains one of the fastest-growing animal food-producing sectors worldwide.
- In fact, it is the only animal food-producing sector growing faster than the human population, and it provides an acceptable supplement to and substitute for wild fish.
