

KUB PREPARATION

- GIVE LAXATIVE DRUGS LIKE DISTILIN AND DULCOLAX.
- GIVE CASTOR OIL (40 TO 50 ML) TO PATIENT AND DRINK AT NIGHT BEFORE SLEEPING.
- ADIVCE SOFT DIET AT NIGHT LIKE DAL AND CHAPATHI.
- 24 HRS PREPARATION IS REQUIRED FOR KUB.
- THE BOWEL HAS NO GASES, THE X RAY RESOLUTION INCREASES AND AVOID OVERLAPPING OF GAS OVER STRECTURES.

ERECT ABDOMEN INDICATIONS SHOULD INCLUDE THE DIAPHRAGMS AND THE SYMPHYSIS PUBIS.

- SUSPECTED GASTROINTESTINAL PERFORATION.
- POSITION OF ANY MEDICAL DEVICES LIKE PERITONEAL TUBE.
- POST OP CASES.
- LOOK FOR FLUID LEVELS AND FREE GAS
- ASCITIS.
- PNEUMOPERITONIUM.



SUPINE ABDOMEN INDICATIONS

THE ROUTINE X-RAY PROJECTION IS THE SUPINE ABDOMINAL FILM AND SHOULD INCLUDE THE DIAPHRAGMS AND THE SYMPHYSIS PUBIS.

- PAIN AND TENDERNESS
- SUSPECTED BOWEL OBSTRUCTION.
- DILATED BOWEL.
- SUSPECTED ABDOMINAL MASS.
- FOREIGN BODIES LIKE EATING SHARP OBJECTS.
- SUSPECTED BILIARY STONES.
- POST OP CASES.

ABDOMEN LATERAL VIEW INDICATIONS

• TO DIFFERENTIATE THE BOWEL GAS AND PNEUMOPERITONEUM.

- UNCOPARATIVE PATIENTS.
- IF PATIENT IS UNFIT TO STAND.


PREPARATION

- COLLECT HISTORY FROM PATIENT.
- PATIENT IS ASKED TO REMOVE ALL RADIOPAQUE MATERIALS.
- WEAR HOSPITAL GOWN.
- SHIELDING IS PROVIDED TO PATIENT.
- AT THE TIME OF EXPOSURE, PATIENT IS ASKED TO TAKE BREATH.
 EXPOSURE TAKE DURING ARRESTED INSPIRATION
- IF FEMALE PATIENT COME TO X RAY, CHAPERONE IS NECESSARY.



KUB POSITIONING

- PATIENT IS SUPINE ON MIDLINE OF THE X RAY TABLE.
- HIS HAND AND ARMS ABOVE THE HEAD. IT IS ENSURED THAT BODY IS STRAIGHT.
- THE UPPER BORDER OF CASSETTE IS JUST ABOVE XIPHISTERNUM AND LOWER BORDER JUST BELOW SYMPHYSIS PUBIS.
- TO INCLUDE BLADDER.
- PATIENT IS IMMOBALISED, SIDE IS MARKED AND BEAM IS COLLIMTED.









POSITIONING OF ERECT X RAY

- PATIENT STANDS IN FRONT OF THE CHEST STAND.
- UPPER BORDER OF THE CASSETTE IS AT THE LEVEL OF NIPPLES.
- PATIENT IS IMMOBALISED, SIDE IS MARKED AND BEAM IS COLLIMATED.
- 1. PA: PATIENT STANDS FACING CHEST STAND.
- 2. AP: PATIENT STANDS FACING TUBE SIDE.



POSITIONING OF SUPINE ABDOMEN

- PATIENT IS SUPINE ON MIDLINE OF THE X RAY TABLE.
- HIS HAND AND ARMS ABOVE THE HEAD. IT IS ENSURED THAT BODY IS STRAIGHT.
- THE UPPER BORDER OF CASSETTE IS JUST ABOVE XIPHISTERNUM AND LOWER BORDER JUST BELOW SYMPHYSIS PUBIS.
- PATIENT IS IMMOBALISED, SIDE IS MARKED AND BEAM IS COLLIMTED.





POSITIONING OF LATERAL VIEW OF ABDOMEN.

- PATIENT LIES IN TRUE LATERAL POSITION ON MIDLINE OF X RAY TABLE.
- HIS ARMS ARE RAISED ABOVE THE HEAD.
- UPPER BORDER OF THE CASEETTE IS AT THE LEVEL OF XIPHISTERNUM.
- PATIENT IS IMMOBILISED, SIDE IS MARKED AND BEAM IS COLLIMATED.




1. SUPINE DECUBITUS:

- PATIENTT LIES SUPINE ON MIDLINE OF X RAY TABLE. IT IS ENSURED THAT TRUNK IS NOT ROTATED.
- CASSETTE IS VERTICALLY SUPPORTED IN CONTACT WITH ONE SIDE OF HIS ABDOMEN.
- UPPER BORDER OF CASSETTE IS AT THE LEVEL OF NIPPLE. BEAM IS COLLIMTED.

2. LATERAL DECUBITUS:

- PATIENT LIES ON X RAY TABLE IN TRUE LATERAL POSITION.
- ARMS ARE RAISED AND RESTED OVER THE HEAD.
- CASSETTE PLACED ON BACK SIDE OF THE BODY, UPPER BORDER AT THE LEVEL OF NIPPLES.
- PATIENT IS IMMOBALISED. BEAM IS COLLIMTED.





CENTERING

- 1. KUB: MIDLINE TO MIDDLE OF CASSETTE OVER UMBILICUS.
- 2. LATERAL: MID AXILLARY LINE TO MIDLINE OF X RAY TABLE.
- 3. ERECT: IT IS DONE ON L3 VERTEBRA.
- 4. SUPINE DECUBITUS: IT IS DONE ON MID AXILLARY LINE TO CENTER OF CASEETTE.
- 5. LATERAL DECUBITUS: IT IS DONE OVER UMBILICUS.
