



## **OCULAR DISEASE**

Hypertelorism




- Increased separation of the eyes.
- Widely separated orbits, and broad nasal
- bridge.



- The interpupillary distance (IPD) may be 85 mm or more.
- Divergent squint, telecanthus and antimongoloid slanting.
- There may be optic atrophy due to associated narrowing of the optic canals.





- Hypertelorism also occurs in:
- ✓ Median facial-cleft syndrome,
- ✓ Apert's syndrome,
- ✓ Crouzon's syndrome, etc.
