ersal **Prot**ein resource, a central repository of protein data ed by combining the Swiss-Prot, TrEMBL and PIRdatabases.

i-ProtKB

- **prot knowledge base** is the central access point for extensive ated protein information, including function, classification, and ss-reference.
- UniprotKB/SWISS-PROT is a manually annotated universal protein database which is always reviewed.
- UniprotKB/TrEMBL is an automatically annotated database and is not reviewed.

i-Prot Reference clusters (UniRef)

vide clustered sets of sequences from the UniProtKB to obtain nplete coverage of sequence space at several resolutions





Types of annotations provided

- Description of a protein's function domain structure, conflicts bet literature references and variants.
- ✓ Provides a high level of integration other bio-molecular databases.

niProtKB/Swiss-Prot is the manually annotated and viewed section of the UniProt Knowledgebase niProtKB).

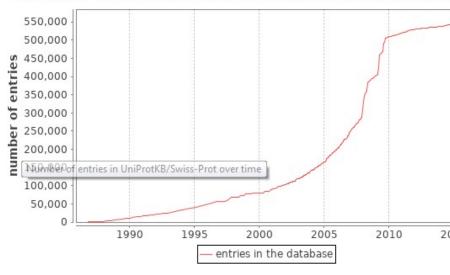

rEMBL is a computer-annotated protein equence database complementing the niprotKB/SWISS-PROT.

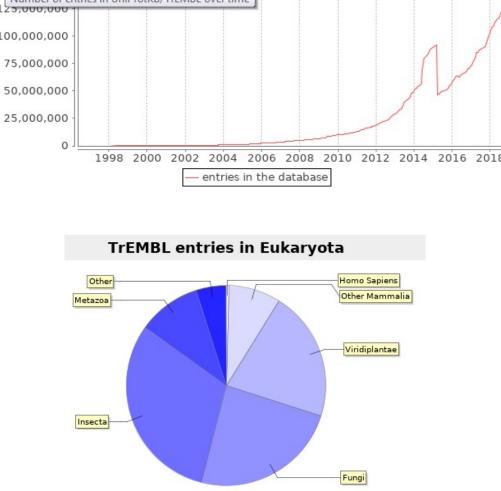
