

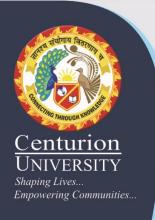
Disease in Gerbera



Crown root

- Caused by Phytophthora cryptogea
- This results in wilting disease of Gerbera
- Crown of the plant becomes black






Management of crown root

These two diseases can be managed by applying following fungicides:


- Fosetyl Aluminium @1.5g/litre
- Thiophanate- Methyl @1g/litre
- Copper oxychloride @4g/litre
- Copper hydroxide @1g/litre of water.



Powdery Mildew

- White powdery growth on the leaf lamina.
- In case of severe attack leaves start curling





Management of Powdery mildew

- Wettable Sulphur @ 1.5 gram
- Mycobutanil @ 0.5 gram per litre





Alternaria Leaf Spot

• Develops when moisture persist on leaf surface for longer duration.

• Black circular spots appears on leaves



Management of Alternaria

• Mancozeb @ 2.5 g/L

• Benomyl 1g/L
