Selection tool:

The Selection tool lets you select text and graphics frames. It also allows you to work with an object using its bounding box.



Direct Selection tool:

The Direct Selection tool lets you select the contents of a frame, such as a placed graphic, or work directly with edit able objects, such as paths, rectangles, or type that has been converted to a text outline.



Page tool:

The Page tool is used when you want to modify the size, orientation, or master item placement within a page. It is often used when working with Liquid Page Rules and when creating Alternate Layouts. Select the Page tool from the Toolbox.



Gap Tool:

The Gap Tool works to adjust the space between adjacent objects or between objects and page edges.



Content Collector tool:

Use the Content Collector tool you can then place those same items with the Content Placer tool elsewhere on the current page, another page, or even in another document.
