What is earthing up?

Soil is drawn-up around the base of a plant to keep it stable, especially in windy weather.

It promotes crop stability.It protects the roots of crops.

Addition of to baser of plants



Advantages

□ Support to plant against heavy wind

- Ensure proper growth in root crops
- □ Strengthening of stem of vegetable crops
- □ Supply essential nutrients to plants
- □ Proper drainage of water





Advantages and Considerations

Maintaining soil moisture

Avoid root damage

Don't walk on hoeing soil
