

Module 2 : Cultural practices followed in cut and loose flowers Session 19 : Intercultural operations in Jasmine




 Jasmine is a perennial shrub and vine which belongs to family
Oleaceae. Widely cultivated for the characteristic fragrance of their flowers.





- All the lighter and finer operations carried out on the soil between sowing and harvesting is known as intercultural operations.
- Such as weeding, fertilizer application, mulching etc.



Intercultural operations in tuberose

Pruning- In jasmine, flowering habit is terminal and axillary. So increasing the number of shoots would increase the yield, for which pruning is essential. Pruning influences growth, flower bud initiation, differentiation and ultimately the flower production. Mostly done at a height of 45-50 cm from ground level.



Mulching- helps to regulate weed and conserves moisture. Mostly plastic mulch is preferred over organic mulch.

➤ Manual weeding-Weeding is done manually.
