Propagation in jasmine is through vegetative methods

a) layering

b) cutting

## **Layering:**

One year old shoots are selected and are buried in the soil 10- 15 cm deep after making a shallow, slanting cut in the portion that is to be buried. The root formation occurs in 90-120 days.

## **Cutting:**

22-25 cm long cuttings with 3-4 nodes are planted in rooting media. Cuttings taken during April-September has highest percentage of rooting with maximum rooting in June planted cuttings.

## **Seed:**

- Propagation through seed is not possible.
- In some species, seed propagation is followed.
