





Session 3: Propagation in jasmine



Propagation in jasmine is through vegetative methods


- a)layering
- b) cutting



Layering:

One year old shoots are selected and are buried in the soil 10-15 cm deep after making a shallow, slanting cut in the portion that is to be buried. The root formation occurs in 90-120 days.





Cutting:


22-25 cm long cuttings with 3-4 nodes are planted in rooting media. Cuttings taken during April-September has highest percentage of rooting with maximum rooting in June planted cuttings.





Seed:

- Propagation through seed is not possible.
- In some species, seed propagation is followed.
