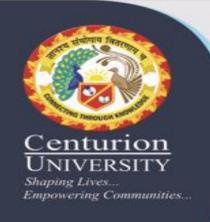

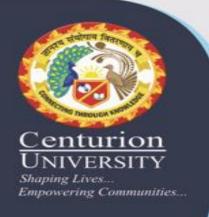

### What is Medicinal plant?

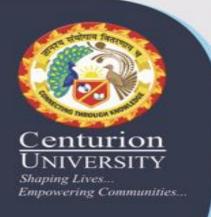
- Medicinal plants are plants that have a recognized medical use.
- Their use ranges the production of mainstream pharmaceutical products to herbal medicine preparations.
- Herbal medicine is one of the oldest forms of medical treatment in human history and could be considered one of the forerunners of the modern pharmaceutical trade.





#### ALOE-VERA (Gritkumari )

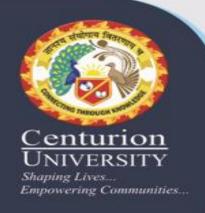
- green leaves contain aloe gel and a sticky yellow residue called latex.
- Burn healing
- Wound healing
- Treat Sunburn
- Radiation-induced skin reactions
- Aloe with conditioner for silkier, smoother hair.
- Take orally to reduce cholesterol and triglycerides for a healthy heart.





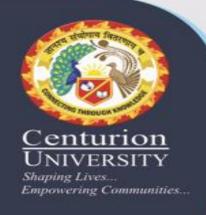
#### ALOE-VERA

- i. Aloe vera is good for irritated or inflamed skin.
- ii. Aloe vera helps repair your skin from the most tender of wounds.
- iii. Aloe vera helps speed the process of healing to burns and other wounds.
- iv. Aloe vera is hydrating, rejuvenating and toning for your skin. v. Aloe vera moisturizes and softens your skin.





- Blood purifier
- Preventive against malaria & dengue fever
- Chewing tulsi leaves relieves cold & flu
- Chewing 12 leaves of basil, twice a day prevent stress.
- The leaves are a nerve tonic & also sharpen memory.
- =  $\rightarrow$  decoction of the leaves + honey + ginger effective remedy for bronchitis, asthma, influenza, cough and cold juice of basil leaves + honey (if taken regularly for 6 months) expel renal stone via the urinary tract.



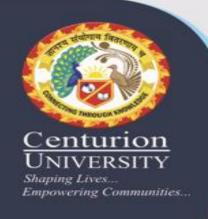
# Tulsi

• Ancient Egyptians thought tulsi was a treatment for snakebites or stings from scorpions, but if you encounter either of these, seek treatment from a doctor instead.

Many people also use fresh tulsi leaves to rub on mosquito bites to relieve discomfort. A tea made with tulsi combined with peppercorns is given as a treatment to reduce fever.

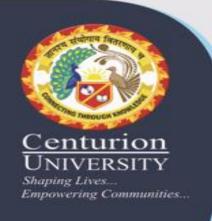
The leaves of holy basil are used all over the world in cooking as a seasoning.

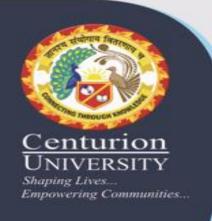
# NEEM

- Neem inhibits allergic reactions when applied externally or eaten.
- Oral doses of neem leaf extracts
- reduced insulin requirements by between 30% and 50% for diabetes.
- Neem extracts give significant protection from discomfort and speed the healing of gastric problems
- Neem quickly kills external parasites and a neem decoction is safer and just as effective as standard treatments for head lice and scabies. .



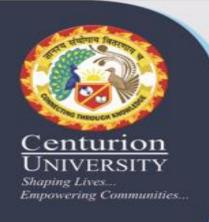
## Periwinkle

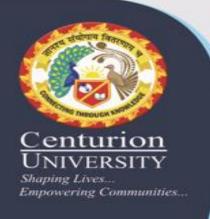


# Bhringaraj

- anti-inflammatory properties, the herb is also used for treating hyperacidity.

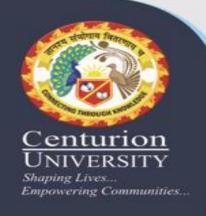




coleus is used to treat allergies, dry eye, skin conditions such as eczema and **psoriasis**,

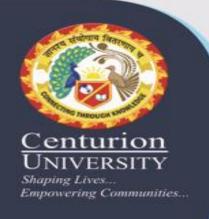

trouble sleeping (insomnia)



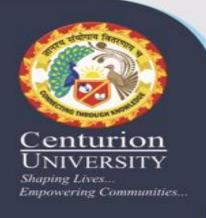
#### **GINGER**

- stomach-soothing effects
- easing post-surgery nausea and vomiting
- Sipping ginger tea can help calm an upset stomach, as well as ease congestion when you've got a cold.
- ginger extract may slow the growth of colorectal and ovarian cancer cells,
- useful in treating chronic inflammation because it partially inhibits two important enzymes that play a role in inflammation gone away -- cyclooxygenase (COX) and 5-lipoxygenase (LOX).



#### **AMLA**

- To stimulate appetite (Use pickles and preserves made from the green fruits)
- For hemorrhage, diarrhea and dysentery
- Seed fried in ghee and ground in conjee is applied as Lep to the forehead to stop bleeding from the nose.
- For hiccup and for painful respiration Use juice or extract of the fruit combined with honey and pipli
- Due to vitamin C and polyphenols, is a antioxidant.

as an insect repellent.

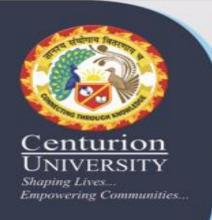
as an antifungal agent.

in **perfumes** or as a flavor additive in **food** 



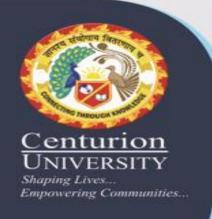
## **Lemon Grass**

It is also used to kill germs and as a mild astringent.

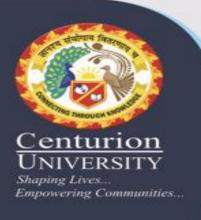


# Rose

They have been also used for commercial perfumery and commercial cut flower crops.

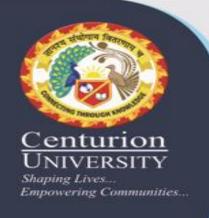
Some are used as landscape plants, for hedging and for other utilitarian purposes such as game cover and slope stabilization.



## **TURMERIC**

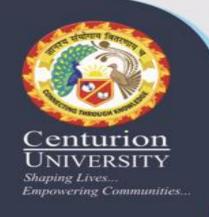
#### **TURMERIC**

- stimulate digestion
- boost liver function
- Curcumin a means of reducing breast cancer risk among women
- When paired with vitamin D, curcumin may help protect against Alzheimer's disease
- curcumin can protect against liver damage.



Plant drugs- This is an age old well known industry manufacturing plant based drugs in traditional systems of medicine such as Ayurveda, Siddha, Homeopathy etc.

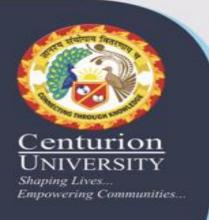
- □ Nutraceuticals- This is a sun rise industry with a large potential for small and medium enterprises.
- ☐ Herbal pesticides- This enterprise has enormous potential in future.
- ☐ Herbal chocolates, sweets etc.- Sugar free sweets, drinks etc are being marketed internationally. Use of herbal extracts in food products is not a new idea.



Use of Medicinal Plants

- □ Seeds: Production and marketing of quality seeds of high yielding varieties (seed companies).
- □ Plant parts (leaf, bark, root, seed etc.)- Enterprises such as large scale cultivation as an agro-industry, marketing of dried plant parts (crude drugs) in national and international markets, establishing market net works can be started.
- ☐ Grading of specific plant parts such as leaves of senna, roots of ashwagandha/ safed musli/ long pepper etc.

This is the simplest but economically viable small enterprise that can be established at farm level and can add value to the harvested produce.
