Size and shape of colloids:

Particles lying in the colloidal size have **large surface area** when compared with the surface area of an equal volume of larger particles.

Specific surface: the surface area per unit weight or volumeof material.

The imoprtance of large specific surface results in:

1- platinum is effective as catalyst only when found in colloidal form due to large surface area which adsorb reactant on their surface.

2- The colour of colloidal dispersion is related to the size of the particles

e.g. red gold sol takes a blue colour when the particles increase in size

-The shape of colloidal particles in dispersion is important:

The more extended the particle the greater its specific surface the greater the attractive force between the particles of the dispersed phase and the dispersion medium.

Flow, sedimentation and osmotic pressure of the colloidal

system affected by the shape of colloidal particles.

Particle shape may also influence the pharmacologic action.



Some shapes that can be assumed by colloidal particles:

(a) spheres and globules,

(b) short rods,

(c) Oblate ellipsoids and flakes, (d) long rods and threads,

(e) loosely coiled threads, and (f) branched threads.
