#### Aim of the Experiment:

### CELL SURFACE HYDROPHOBICITY(CSH) ASSAY

#### Introduction

In order to exert its beneficial effect on the host, a probiotic strain must be able to survive the gut passage of humans to reach to the action site in viable state and should be in sufficient population (normally  $10^7$  cells per ml). Thus, in order to survive in and colonize the gut, the bacteria should express high cell surface hydrophobicity. Cell surface hydrophobicity (CSH) is a biophysical measurement of a cell's affinity for a hydrophobic versus hydrophilic environment. Cells with higher CSH prefer a hydrophobic environment while those with lower CSH will preferentially remain in an aqueous environment. *In-vitro* CSH activity can be assayed against different hydrocarbons *viz. n*-hexadecane, n-octane and xylene.

#### Materials

- 1. Probiotic strain
- 2. PUM buffer (pH-6.5)
- 3. Microplate reader
- 4. Test tubes
- 5. Centrifuge
- 6. *n*-hexadecane, *n*-octane and xylene

## Procedure

- 1. Activate the probiotic culture to be tested for overnight.
- 2. Activated cultures were harvested by centrifugation at 6000g for 10 min, washed pellet twice with phosphate urea magnesium buffer (PUM, pH 6.5) and finally re-suspend in the same buffer.
- 3. The final OD<sub>580</sub> was maintained near to 0.7-0.8, for each culture (200  $\mu$ L), respectively.
- 4. One milliliter, of cell suspension was separately mixed with 0.3 mL, each of three hydrocarbons in acid resistant tubes to fractionate two phases.
- 5. Following, a 10 min preincubation at 37°C, to equilibrate temperature, the samples were again vortex and allows standing in an incubator at 37°C for 60 min.
- 6. The aqueous phase  $(200 \ \mu L)$  was aspirated gently and placed in a microplate reader.
- 7. A decrease in absorbance from the initial reading was considered as a measure of percent CSH and was calculated as:

 $CSH\% = [(A_0 - A)/A_0] \times 100,$ 

Where, A<sub>0</sub> and A are the readings of the aqueous phase before and after the extraction at
